CURBING REQUIREMENTS

FOR OAK LAWN AND SAND HILL CEMETERIES, DECATUR, TX

- 1. Curbs must be eight inches (8") wide on the north side, east side, and south side.
- 2. Curbs must be sixteen inches (16") wide on the west side and must be poured level. This is to allow a firm, level, solid foundation on which to set the monuments later.
 - (NOTE: Monuments are not allowed to be set directly on the ground without a cement foundation underneath it. Monuments which are set on the curbing have a much more solid foundation than just using a cement slab under the monuments.)
- 3. Curbs must be six inches (6") thick, using 2x6 boards and digging three to six inches (3-6") deeper inside the forms. Curbs must originate no higher than one inch from the highest corner of burial lot. Curbs cannot exceed 6 inches in height above the ground. Curbs must be stair-stepped down to meet the height requirements.
- 4. Two (2) steel rods must be used on the sides which are eight inches (8") wide (north, east, and south sides.)
- 5. Three (3) steel rods must be used on the west side which is sixteen inches (16") wide.
- 6. The steel rods must tie in at the corners, using an "L-shape" to tie them together.
- 7. The cement must have a slick finish, not a broom finish.
- 8. Nothing is to be laid into the cement to be part of the finished product, such as sea shells, glass pieces, ornamental decorations, etc.
- 9. No cement slabs are allowed to cover any part or all of a grave.
- 10. After the forms are set, it <u>must be inspected</u> by one of the people listed below <u>before the cement can be poured</u>.
